## **Recommended Student Supplies 2024-2025 School Year**

Dear Parents,

To ensure some level of standardization, teachers ask that you follow the "shopping list" below as closely as possible. If you are not sure about a particular item, please contact the school before purchasing it.

Please make sure you label your supplies with your child's full name before bringing them to school.

Students should bring their supplies with them on the first full day of school.

Please note that some homerooms will request their students to bring in specific items. Your child will be notified of these specifics once school starts.

**Student Agendas** – will be supplied to each student in grades 5 and 6. No agendas will be available for grade 7 and 8 students.

**Footwear** - Students are asked to remove outdoor shoes when entering the school and use a clean pair for inside.

**Gym strip -** Students are required to change into shorts/sweats and a T-shirt for Phys.Ed. All participants must wear running shoes with non-marking soles in the gym. CW Perry specific gym strip will be available for purchase for \$30 (includes Spartan t-shirt and shorts). These items will be available for purchase in September.
